7 dedicated pickleball courts coming to Whatcom Community College

## Plan

- Create 7 dedicated pickleball courts at Whatcom Community College
- 3 courts with interior fences (wheel chair accessible) ADA compliant
- 4 courts without interior fences
- Courts will be open to the community as well as WCC students and staff

### Cost

- Claude Blackburn is generously donating half the total cost for this project, so every fundraising dollar is being matched
- WCC is paying to resurface these courts
- BPC needs to raise between \$23,000 without lights and \$53,000 with lights to cover the remaining costs.


