The mission of the Bellingham Pickleball Club (BPC) is to promote the development of pickleball skills facilities and community in the greater Bellingham area.

Incorporated as a non-profit club in May 2018 the BPC is organized by a volunteer board of directors. As of Dec 2021 the upcoming tasks are: Engage with local community organizations such as Bellingham Park Dept, WWC, Port of Bham, WWU, Whatcom YMCA, Bellingham Fitness & Bellingham School District. Recruit and activate volunteers. Organize opportunities for varying levels of play and skill-development. Host indoor and outdoor skill-development and open play. Support the Bellingham Park Department in expanding the number of pickleball courts. Maintain & improve Cornwall Park courts and facilities.

BPC Board of Director Elections and Annual General Meeting are held in August.
